Face masks

Although it is no longer a legal obligation Railtex / Infrarail recommend everyone onsite wears face masks, except those who are exempt. They should be worn at all times and in all areas of the show.



Cleaning & hygiene

You must provide disinfectant dispensers within the stand design. All high touch points should be cleaned regularly with appropriate cleaning materials during build-up, show days and breakdown.
